Final Tranche of Economic Stimulus Package

Industries

- Debts related to Covid 19 shall be excluded from IBC.
- No fresh insolvency proceedings upto 1 year.
- Minimum threshold to initiate insolvency proceedings raised to ₹1 crore from ₹1 lakh.
- Decriminalisation of Companies Act violations involving minor technical and procedural defaults.



- Majority of compoundable offences sections to be shifted to internal adjudication mechanism.
- Permission of Direct listing of securities in foreign jurisdiction.
- Companies with only listed NCDs will be not be listed companies.
- Lower penalties for all defaults for small companies, one-person companies, producer companies and start-ups.
- All sectors will be open to private sectors whereas OSUs in certain areas will be privatised.
- Broadly categorisation of strategic sectors.
- Max 4 PSUs in strategic sectors, others to be privatised and merged.
